Parish Council News

A resident who walks her dog along the main road has written to the Parish Council to ask if anything more can be done about the excessive speeds done by drivers, despite the 30mph speed limit. She noted that the speed camera van regularly attends, but has to make it's presence known, which rather defeats the object of the exercise. She asked if the Parish council would consider installing 'check your speed' devices. As these would have to be purchased by the village through the local rates precept, if you have an opinion on this, please contact one of the Parish Councillors.

County Councillor Noi Sear informed the Parish Council that the A1104 will be closed for re-surfacing between the Willows Caravan Park and Mablethorpe for approximately 10 WEEKS, with work commencing mid October. There will be access to residents properties but no through road and diversions will be in place.

Residents are welcome to attend Parish Council Meetings and can ask questions, raise points and make comments in a ten minute session before the meeting commences at 7pm. The next meeting will take place on Monday 9th September, again on 11th November and 13th January 2025.
