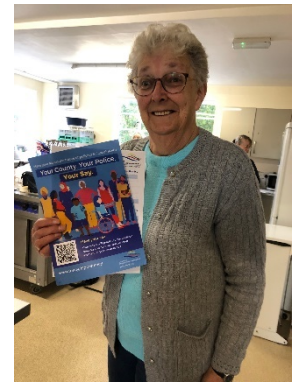
Happy New Year!

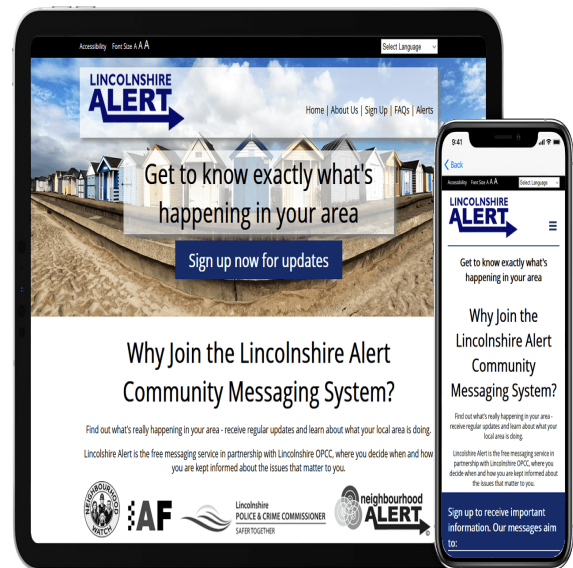
