At the end of 2021 we held a successful World Café event, this was a listening event where residents shared the thoughts and insights on all thing's community safety.

Following this local community groups were able to put in a bid of up to £2,500 from a pot of £15,000 for projects which would benefit the residents of Skegness. Over 70 people attended the PB event at Tower Gardens were each project had 3 minutes to present their bids to the local community who voted for those who they thought should receive funding.

Seven projects were successful and are now well underway to helping the local community including taking children off the streets, providing safe spaces, therapy ponies visiting care homes and much more.
